



No sooner does Anni arrive than frightening and unexplainable things start happening. Strange visions, whispers in the walls, and unnerving nightmares plague her first days and nights, compounding her grief and rattling her spirit. Anni fears that her return to Metsan Valo has invited less of a welcoming and more of a warning.

Once Anni's grandmother's final wishes are revealed in a heated reading of the will, family tensions reach a fever pitch. However, when tragedy strikes the home for a second time, Anni and her

family set out to unspool a mystery that spans centuries. A mystery that seems fiercely relentless in its desire to be uncovered.
